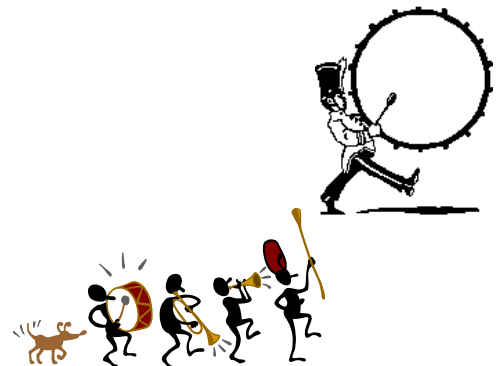

PARADE REGULATIONS

PARTICIPANTS MUST ADHERE TO THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS:

1. All Entries are asked to report to their designated starting area no later than 9:00 a.m. in order to receive instructions and line up order.

Please refer to the enclosed map to determine the location and your parade starting point.

Bands - Please assemble at the corner of Fair & Walnut Street at the University Park area.

Floats - Please assemble on Beckwith Street and Walnut St..

Cars - Please assemble at the parking lot located at the rear of the Oglethorpe Administration Building.

All Marching and Nonmusic Units please assemble at the Coretta Scott King Young Women's Leadership Academy parking lot. (601 Beckwith Street, Atlanta, GA 30314)

Special Note: If you are a Marching Unit with a car or float, please assemble in the area where your car or float is located, in order to ensure that the group will be together.

2. All entries should do their best to alleviate gaps in the parade. (Long distances between entries will create an "eyesore" and detract interest from the parade.)
3. Bands are requested to use moving performances only. (Standing shows delay the movement of the parade.) Standing Performances are allowed at the viewing stand only.
4. Band Directors are requested to instruct their band members not to create individual drumming or instrumental-playing competitions while the parade is in progress. (Such sideshows create a major distraction to the overall parade.)

Please assist us in these matters to help make this a very enjoyable occasion.
